**Chief Guest Shrimati Dr. Indumati M Nambi, Professor in Environment and Water Resources Division Department of Civil Engineering, IIT Madras.** She enlighten us on renewable resources of energy to protect earth, environment, water and other natural resources.



**Key Note Speaker Mr. Richard N. Bright, Director, Network for Certification and Conservation of Forest (NCCF),** has explained about Carbon Registry - India (CR-I) and how the carbon registry provides platform to the organizations to track, manage and trade greenhouse gas emissions.



**Mr. BVS Shekhar, Associate Director (CP&CC) in NPCIL,** has explained the Environmental Concerns about Nuclear Power, how to mitigate Climate Change and reduce green house gas emissions.



**Mr. GR Srinivasan Former Vice Chairman, Atomic Energy Regulatory Board (AERB),** has explained whether Nuclear Power is a destroyer or protector.



**Dr. SK Malhotra Secretary, India Nuclear Society,** has explained about India's Mission Zero Emission by 2070 - Strategies and Technology Options.

**Key Note Speaker Shri Vinay Deodhar, a Climate Change Mitigation Specialist.** He enlightened us on Paris Agreement – Perspectives and Relevance for Industry. He gave information on International Response to Climate right from the beginning i.e. from 1979 to Paris Agreement. He also described the salient features of Paris Agreement, the Goal set to limit global warming to well below 2 degree C, Pursuing efforts to below 1.5 degree C compared to pre-industrial levels, measures for adoption, Sustainable Development focus and the important developments regarding Paris Agreement.



**Shri Anoop Nautiyal, the Founder of Social Development for Communities Foundation (Dehradun).** He shared his thoughts on Plastic Waste Management. He related use of plastic with adverse impact on human health and expressed concern about single use of plastic and plastic recycling. He also gave simple tips that every one can do regarding use of plastic in our day to day life and protecting our health from ill effects of plastics.



**Shri Shashi Vardhan Pandey, Former GM, IOCL.** He shared his thoughts on topic Marine Oil Spill Response Management in India. During his presentation, he enlightened us on the Major sources of Oil Spill, Consequences of an Oil Spill and response to oil spill. He also gave information on the national oil spill disaster contingency plan, oil spill response equipments and it's use, oil spill response preparedness by Indian oil industry.



**Dr. Sakshi Jain, Executive Officer, Udaipur Industrial Waste Management & Research Center.** She shared her thoughts on topic Environmental Impact Assessment and process of environmental clearance. In her presentation, she enlightened us on the objectives and content of environmental impact assessment. She also explained the project categorization, environmental clearance process, key steps in environmental clearance, it's monitoring and validity of environmental clearance.



**Prof. Vijay Page, the Founder Director, Brahma Research Foundation, Mumbai** shared his thoughts on topic Water Resource Optimization Riding New Approaches To Green Power And Green Cover Carpeting. During his presentation, he emphasized on necessity of increasing ground water by using new technologies and integrated approach with examples like developing water bodies while constructing new highways and railways, potential for utilizing of submerged dam areas by installing solar panels for solar energy. He also informed the possibilities of green power through river hydroelectricity and green cover on creek / wetlands and utilizing chilled water discharge of millions of A/Cs

**BK Suraj Bhajji, International Motivational Speaker from Brahma Kumari's**, spoke on the concluding day of national conclave-PARYAVARTAN-ONLY ONE EARTH- to commemorate World Environment Week on 4th June. BK Suraj Bhajji pointed at the habit of unbridled consumption in this era. The root-cause of land, air and water pollution is our unsated desire to buy things we want, but strictly, do not need. When people are internally agitated, they attempt to seek temporary happiness from external sources- indulging in wasteful buying, assuming that this will calm their turmoil. When the negative emotions like anger, hatred, and jealousy dominate inside, one finds outlet in binge-eating, binge-buying and going overboard hoarding materials and goods irrationally. The notional happiness one feels this way is ephemeral and the mind recoils to its initial state of agitation rather swiftly



**Mr. S Sittarasu, Chief Business Development Officer, Deendayal Port Authority, Kandla.** His topic was Make in India. Make in India is a major national programme of the Government of India designed to facilitate investment, foster innovation, enhance skill development, protect intellectual property and build best in class manufacturing infrastructure in the country.



**Master Sidharth Kukunuri, our most youngest speaker** chose a very unique and very important topic "Trees outside forests: to expand the tree cover". He has triggered us to know and to think about Growing Trees outside Forests (ToF) presents a significant environmental and economic opportunity in India. 
**Mr. Gowri S Kowtha , Managing Principal in Status Environmental Inc.** apprise us about Oil Spill Management on Land (Land Pollution). Hydrocarbons are compounds made up of carbon and hydrogen. Hydrocarbon pollution has far reaching implications for both terrestrial and aquatic ecosystem as well as in the atmosphere. It has been a problem ever since the use of fossil fuels began. The extraordinary increase of populations and also industrial development in both developing and developed countries during the last century have increased the threat of extensive pollution in the environment. Dr. Gowri has explained very crisply & effectively that during petroleum exploration the oil contaminate the land, and Bioremediation is an eco-friendly and economic method to remove the petroleum pollutants from soil. There are several kinds of bioremediation which have been applied to remediate the petroleum hydrocarbon from contaminated soils, such as phytoremediation, rhizoremediation, biostimulation, bioaugmentation, and so on.



**Prof. Prakash Sahasrabudhe from Vishwa Adhyayan Kendra** educated the viewer and we are so lucky to listen him on a very important subject Way Beyond Prevention, which is a key to any success in our life. Prevention is better than cure. Considering the importance, Risk-based thinking has replaced preventive action in almost all current management system standard and it provides a structured approach to managing quality/environmental issues that are likely to impact on your organisation. Determining the risks and identifying potential opportunities are crucial to an organisations success. We whole heartedly thank Prof. Prakash Sahasrabudhe for sparing his valuable time and educating us.



**Dr. Vijay N Bade, Medical Director Vighanaharta Sai Hospital & Laboratory, Pune** has enlightened us on Biomedical Waste Management & its phenomenal impact. Segregation, storage and safe disposal of the waste is very crucial in the effective management of biomedical waste at workplace. 




